

# Preeclampsia

Nursing surveillance with remote patient monitoring



## Highlights:

- All equipment and supplies included and delivered to the patient's home
- Frequent monitoring and clinical evaluation
- Actional, biometric data via wireless telemetry equipment
- Identifies changes in clinical status which may indicate instability related to development or progression
- Preeclampsia service includes 14-day postpartum surveillance
- Compliance monitoring
- 24/7 access to OB RN support
- Weekly clinical reporting

## Benefits:

- Frequent assessment of clinical status
- Timely identification of disease state progression
- Reduces office calls and after-hours contacts from patients
- Comprehensive documentation of adherence to plan of care

## Clinical criteria:

- **At Risk for Preeclampsia** – 20+ weeks gestation and has risk factors for developing preeclampsia. Chronic hypertension patients may be accepted into the At Risk for Preeclampsia service prior to 20 weeks GA for blood pressure surveillance.
- **Preeclampsia** – 20+ weeks gestation diagnosed with preeclampsia with absence of severe features
- **Postpartum Preeclampsia** – Diagnosed at delivery or following delivery, as being at risk for preeclampsia or with preeclampsia without severe features
